Who We Are

Nevada Health Centers (NVHC) is a nonprofit Community Health Center serving the state of Nevada with more than 15 health centers and mobile healthcare services. NVHC was one of the first Federally Qualified Community Health Centers (FQHCs) in 1977, as authorized under the Public Health Service Act of 1976.

Welcome to your Patient-Centered Medical Home (PCMH)

Nevada Health Centers has earned national recognition for Patient-Centered Medical Home care from the National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA). The award recognizes evidence-based, patient-centered processes focusing on highly coordinated care and long-term participative relationships. It's all about you, the person in the middle of our PCMH model. We want to meet your needs and include you in your care plan.

Nevada Health Centers Mammovan

The NVHC mobile mammography van travels across Nevada, providing mammograms to women with or without insurance. The Mammovan is supported primarily through grant funding, and services approximately 3,000 women each year. An easy way to support the Mammovan is to purchase a Nevada Health Centers Breast Cancer Awareness license plate at dmv.nv.com.

Ronald McDonald Care Mobile - Dental Service Provider

The Ronald McDonald Care Mobile travels throughout rural Nevada, providing restorative and preventive dental care for children. The Care Mobile is supported in part by the Ronald McDonald House Charities.

Women, Infants and Children (WIC)

NVHC is contracted with the state of Nevada to provide seven WIC sites in Clark County. WIC is a nutritional education and food voucher program offered to eligible pregnant and breastfeeding women, their infants and their older children with special nutritional needs.

What We Do

We provide access to quality care throughout frontier, rural and urban areas of Nevada. NVHC is the largest provider of primary care for the uninsured and/or geographically isolated in the state, as well as for those with Medicaid, Medicare or commercial insurance. In some cases, the rural health centers operated by NVHC are the only healthcare facilities for residents to access without traveling long distances.

How to Use Our Services

Our services are available primarily by appointment, but we do our best to accommodate walk-ins. The following payment sources are accepted:
